

After every person put a paper on their forehead, so all of the participants beside the person with a paper know the word. The aim of the game is to guess your word with questions, but people can answer only with « yes » or « no ». If people answer « yes » you continue asking questions. If you receive « no » to your question, the next player start to ask.	It's just fun and interesting
8	Ukraine	inside	Monopoly	A special game board, figures, dice, street cards, and game currency	Each participant has a certain amount of game currency and must buy as many streets as possible and then use them to earn more money.	The ability to negotiate with other players to buy or trade streets. In my opinion, the game helps develop negotiation skills.
9	Iran	outside	StoneGame	7 flat stones and a small ball	Two teams play against each other. One team stacks 7 stones, and the other tries to knock them down with a ball and rebuild them without being hit.	It is a traditional Iranian team game that requires a lot of movement and teamwork. The participant would develop a game that combines classic Persian elements with modern technology (e.g., AR Haft Sang). The focus would be on promoting teamwork and

10	Syria	inside	Daughters-Mothers Game	No special rules for this game	Clothes and dolls	The game is special because many people can participate, and we can choose how to organize or design it.
11	Ukraine	outside inside	as many as possible	No	Hide and seek: one player is the seeker who closes their eyes and counts while the others hide. After counting, the seeker looks for the hidden players, and the game ends when everyone is found.	Childhood memories
12	Ukraine	inside	2-6	Board game with cards	Catan: a multiplayer strategy board game where players settle an island by building roads, settlements, and cities. Each turn, dice rolls determine which terrain hexes produce resources (wood, brick, sheep, wheat, ore), which players collect. Players use these resources to build and expand, trade with others, or buy development cards. The robber can block resource production and steal from opponents. The goal is to be the first to reach 10 victory points , earned through buildings, special cards, and achievements like longest road or largest army.	You can rely on the luck of the dice and think strategically. The game has an expansion pack, so you can play with a large number of people. It's great to play with a big group. I love playing with close friends. It brings people

						together and you can have a great time.
13	Ukrainian	outside	6-15, or more	No (but enough space)	Fox & Geese: one player becomes the "fox," and the others are the "geese." The geese stand on one side, while the leader stands in the middle. After a short dialogue, the geese run to the other side, and the leader tries to catch them. Those who are caught either become the leader or help them.	Associated with childhood, friends and freedom.
14	Slavic	inside	from 2	Playing cards	Durak (Fool): a popular card game. The goal of the game is to get rid of all your cards. The player who is left with cards at the end is called the durak. After shuffling, one card is turned face up to determine the trump suit, which beats all other suits. Each player is dealt 6 cards. The player with the lowest trump card starts the game. One player attacks by playing a card, and the next player defends by beating it with a higher card of the same suit or with a trump card. Other players may add cards of the same rank as those already played. If the defender cannot beat all the cards, they must take them into their hand. If the defender successfully beats all cards, they become the next attacker. After each round, players draw cards from the deck to have up to 6 cards again. The game continues until all cards are played. The last player who still has cards loses and becomes the durak.	The company I play with, communication with them.

They score by hitting the ball and running to the opposite end or hitting the ball to the boundary (4 runs if it hits the ground, 6 runs if it clears the rope).</p> <p>Bowling: The bowler tries to hit the wickets or force a mistake to get the batter "out."</p> <p>Ways to get "Out"</p> <p>Bowled: The ball hits the wickets.</p> <p>Caught: A fielder catches the hit ball before it touches the ground.</p> <p>LBW: The ball hits the batter's leg when it was going to hit the wickets.</p> <p>Run Out: Fielders hit the wickets with the ball while the batters are running.</p> <p>Stumped: The wicket-keeper hits the stumps while the batter is out of their safe zone.</p>	This game was played in our childhood.
